Libraries are a place where people of all ages and from all walks of life can connect to ideas, information and to each other. Whether in person or online, library users have a world of information available at their fingertips. The public library engages people throughout their lives to support lifelong learning.

One way JCPL supports lifelong learning is through the Adult Learning Center. The ALC is a dedicated space for adults that facilitates the development of basic educational skills, English language skills, cross-cultural learning and more. The ALC logged nearly 1,000 hours of one-on-one tutoring time in 2019.

The two hard-working staff members supporting this department host over 250 programs and events with more than 1,200 people attending each year. From the annual Thanksgiving celebration to the department's signature event, the Adult Spelling Bee, the ALC finds fun and engaging opportunities to support literacy in our community. One might even see ALC staff members with a group of learners on a field trip to traditional Johnson County events like Strawberries on the Square or the Johnson County 4-H Fair.
